

572D ENGINEER COMPANY (LE)

"WE MOVE THE EARTH" IS THE MOTTO OF THE 572D ENGINEER COMPANY (LE), AND THE MOTTO IS NO IDLE BOAST. THE 572D HAS PERFORMED EARTHMOVING, ROAD BUILDING, AND QUARRY OPERATIONS IN BOTH WORLD WAR II AND VIETNAM. CONSTITUTED IN 1943 AS A DUMP TRUCK COMPANY, THE "DUCE" WAS REORGANIZED AS A LIGHT EQUIPMENT COMPANY IN 1955. IN LATE 1965, THE 572D WAS ALERTED FOR DUTY IN SOUTH VIETNAM AND ARRIVED IN-COUNTRY ON 15 JANUARY 1966.

THE COMPANY HAS COMPILED AN IMPRESSIVE CONSTRUCTION RECORD IN SOUTH VIETNAM. THE UNIT HAS PARTICIPATED IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF CAM RANH BAY, VITAL QL 1, VONG HO BAY, NORTH BEACH AIRFIELD IN TUY HOA, AND CURRENTLY QL 20 IN LAM DONG PROVINCE, PROVIDING CRUSHED ROCK NECESSARY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS IN VIETNAM. THE 572D HAS OPERATED QUARRIES AT CHOP CHI, NEAR TUY HOA AND AT CHI CONG, NEAR BAO LOC.

THE MISSION OF A LIGHT EQUIPMENT COMPANY IS TO SUPPORT COMBAT ENGINEER OPERATIONS SPECIALIZED ENGINEER EARTHMOVING AND CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT. TO DO SO, THE 572D IS ORGANIZED INTO FIVE PLATOONS AND A COMPANY HEADQUARTERS. THREE LINE PLATOONS OPERATE THE HEAVY EARTHMOVING EQUIPMENT, THE SUPPORT PLATOON RUNS THE ROCK CRUSHER AND QUARRY, PLUS OTHER SPECIALIZED EQUIPMENT. MAINTENANCE PLATOON PROVIDES ORGANIZATIONAL LEVEL MAINTENANCE. DUE TO ITS IMPORTANT MISSION, A LIGHT EQUIPMENT COMPANY IS ONE OF THE LARGEST TYPES OF EQUIPMENT COMPANIES IN THE ARMY.

SINCE MOVING TO BAO LOC IN SUPPORT OF THE 116TH ENGINEER BATTALION (CBT), THE DUCE HAS BEEN ENGAGED IN THE UP-GRADING OF QL 20 THROUGH EXTREMELY DIFFICULT TERRAIN AND WEATHER. 1LT DAVID MARGESON LED THE 572D INTO BAO LOC, BUT MOST OF THE CONSTRUCTION DONE THIS YEAR WAS COMPLETED UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF CPT FREDERICK M. HOWARD. CPT HOWARD LEFT THE "DUCE" TO TAKE COMMAND OF A LAND CLEARING COMPANY ON 25 JULY

THE 572D IS NOW UNDER THE COMMAND OF 1LT RICHARD T. BROWN.
